Brothers and Sisters,

There's a lot happening in our country this month. Many states in the South and Midwest were hit with **severe weather** coming as storms, tornadoes and floods. In order to help our brothers and sisters in these regions, Bishop Lennon has asked that we do a **special collection this weekend** to help them. This Friday our country remembers the horrifying ruling of **Roe v. Wade** in 1973 which legalized abortion. Christians and people of good will have done so much since then to help create a culture of life, forgiveness, and healing in the face of this evil. Many of our own parishioners pray daily for an end to abortion. They offer witness to Christ's sacrificial love at abortion facilities and give hope to men and women who are led to believe abortion is an actual solution to a problem, and are actively involved in Cleveland pro-life organizations. If you are interested in taking a stand with them in any of these ways, talk to me and I will help you connect.

**Our Lifeteen group is taking a pilgrimage to Washington D.C. to participate in the March for Life this Friday.** There, they will join nearly a million others to pray and walk in defense of human life from conception to natural death. Please pray for their safety and offer thanks for their courage to stand for human life.

For those of us who cannot attend the March, Ss. Robert & William is hosting a **Holy Hour for Life** on the eve of the March for Life: **Thursday, January 21 at 6:30 pm.** Please join us for a powerful hour of Eucharistic Adoration with Jesus. We will pray for an end to abortion, for a deep and profound respect for human life, and for those who are traveling to D.C. to participate in the March.

Finally, this is **Christian Unity Week.** The Body of Christ is a body with many wounds, shown in disunity among Christians and the fragmentations of denominations. Many of these wounds go centuries back and require much healing and reconciliation. **The prayer of Christian Unity week is the prayer of Jesus: "That they may all be one" (John 17:21).** The unity, the 'oneness,' that Jesus prays for is a love that goes beyond purely human affections. We love our enemies not because they are necessarily lovable, but because of a divine command to seek reconciliation and unity among all human beings. The Church is 'catholic' (i.e. universal) because, in and through Christ, this reconciliation with our enemies is really possible...universally. **No wound or division anywhere in the universe is too deep for Christ's healing and unifying touch.** Pray this week with Jesus for catholic (universal) unity with our brothers and sisters in Christ.

### **Annulments, Marriage, and the First Step**

Picking up the pieces of one’s life after divorce is an area that can impact one’s relationship with God and the Church. “What is my place in the Church? Can I go to Mass and Communion? Can the Church help me heal? If I decide to marry again, what do I have to do?” The **First Step Program** helps individuals with these questions, especially those who have experienced divorce. Participants will learn about the Church’s *teaching* on marriage, divorce, and remarriage, and *ministry* to the divorced and separated, hear about the annulment process and submitting a case (**no fees required**), and discover a path to healing. 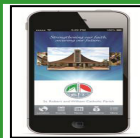
