Dear Parishioners,

Things have settled down a bit around here after Lent, Holy Week, Easter, and Divine Mercy Sunday. However, they will gear up again soon with Taste of Nations, First Communion, Confirmation, 8th grade graduation, and the end of the school year for our day school and PSR. I do love Spring and all the activities that go with it.



A few weeks ago, Chris Kelley, our Youth Minister informed me that he has discerned that it is time for him to move on to a new career path. He is engaged and getting married in October. He feels that youth ministry and the schedule it requires will not be conducive to his marriage. After much prayer and conversation with his support system he felt God was calling him in a different direction. He will be leaving SRW and St. John of the Cross at the end of May. He has done a wonderful job building youth ministry at our parish and then bringing together our parish with St. John of the Cross to form Euclid Lifeteen. Chris is wonderful at relating to the teens, helping to meet them where they are, and helping to lead them closer to Christ. I am so proud of his work these last six years and will really miss him! He is a great man. I know he will make a great husband and do well at whatever God has in store for him next! We will have a good-bye send-off for Chris in late May.

Fr. Sal (Pastor of St. John of the Cross) and I will be working together to hire a new youth minister. Please keep this process in your prayers.

Over the last year we have been working at growing our Music Ministry. I think with the addition of Kyle Lorek, our music ministry has done great things. In that spirit and in talking with Kyle, Jim Markel, and Fr. Scott, I am making the following changes in our music ministry:

- Kyle will become the Director of Music and lead our music ministry for both the parish and the school.
- Jim will assist Kyle, primarily by being our organist/pianist and leading the Resurrection (Funeral) Choir.
- The choir will move out from behind the "wall" and move to the area where the Bell Choir plays. We will remove 6 pews to create a choir area. There will be little to no cost for this move because the work will be done by our maintenance staff. Everything will move out except the organ console. This will happen in a few weeks and allow for the choir to be more a part of the congregation and allow us to sing with them more.
- The current choir area will have seating for the few times a year we do not have enough seating for Mass. In addition, we will move a statue of St. Joseph in there that we have in the school (from the former St. Robert Church) and create a shrine area to St. Joseph with candles, etc.

I do believe these changes will help continue to grow and improve our music ministry. Music is so important to the Mass and I am confident under Kyle's leadership and the great music ministers we have we will come to have a great music ministry here at SRW.

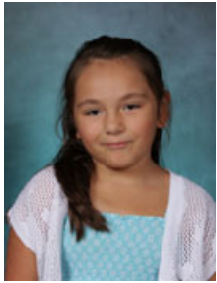
## LIFELONG FAITH FORMATION for all Generations
