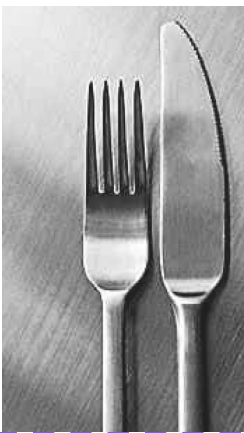

Today's First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles reports the happenings on Pentecost. It was on this day that the Holy Spirit was gifted to Jesus' followers and on this day we received the gifts of the Holy Spirit, which allow us to live, proclaim, and model a Christian way of life. We hear that "they were all together in one place" when this occurred. That is what we do when we gather, and that is what we are doing at this moment. At Mass we share gifts, especially the gift of the Eucharist, but we also share a love for God, a trust in the Lord.

In the Second Reading, in which St. Paul writes to the Corinthians, he speaks of the spiritual gifts we have received. He points out that the gifts we receive may vary in some ways. Nevertheless, all of our gifts combined make up the Body of the Church. Are you using your gifts? Have you prayed and considered what they might be and how you might use them to serve the Church and one another? We must understand that the gifts we have received are intended to benefit all, not just us. Pentecost serves as a reminder to us that we must do that for the Church to be whole and for the Church, including our parish, to be effective.

Pentecost falls 50 days after Easter. Our Gospel Reading from St. John records the first time Jesus appeared to His Apostles after the Resurrection. Jesus says, "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." We have been given a mission to continue the work of Christ here and now. Every time we gather for Mass and receive Christ through the Eucharist we should have an awareness and an understanding of that mission. When we leave here today, whenever we go out in the world, we are to share and spread the Good News.

The best way to do that has to do with how we live; what those around us see and experience through us. There is an idea that best explains what that means; that concept is **stewardship**. On Pentecost it became clear to the followers of Jesus that they were the stewards of His mission, the stewards of His Church. That sense of stewardship has been handed down for centuries and now rests on us. With the help of the Lord, permeated with the Holy Spirit, we need to go forth from here; indeed we need to go forth each and every day, to accomplish that mission. That is what the Church is all about, and that is what life should be all about for us. (*The Catholic Steward*)
