Dear SRW Family,

We often ask each other "How are you?" and receive the response, "BUSY!" Sound familiar? At root of so much of our stress is the busyness of our lives. The remedy? Silence.

Call it reflection, meditation, prayer, or leisure - we need silence. Silence isn't the absence of communication but an invitation to deeper communion. Without silence, no true dialogue can take place. Every communication requires a speaker and a listener, one who speak in words and one who listens in silence. This interplay between word and silence creates the intimacy of communion.

Silence is the key to unlock the hidden life of Jesus. Notice in the Gospels you never hear that Jesus is too 'busy' for people. Even as he leads a very active life of working, preaching, teaching, and healing, the most amazing aspect of Jesus' life is the hidden part spent in silence: 40 days in the desert, overnight on the mountain, asleep in the stern (amidst a raging storm, mind you!), and genuinely listening to the needs of others around him ("What do you want me to do for you?"). Here we see Jesus listening to the voice of the Father in order to do his will. Jesus invites us to follow him in his hidden life of prayer to give us communion with God and the spiritual energy to do his work.

This past year, Mary and Jesus have been leading me in a special way to enter an extended period of silence to listen to God. With the blessing of Fr. John, my spiritual director, and the Diocese of Cleveland, I will be participating in a 30 day retreat this summer...no, that is not a typo! This 30 day retreat will take place at Creighton University in Omaha, Nebraska as part of an Ignatian Spiritual Exercises retreat offered by the Institute for Priestly Formation. I will be leaving for this 30 day retreat next Sunday morning, June 25 and will conclude my retreat on Monday, July 31. During this retreat, I will meet daily with a spiritual director who who will help guide my exercises of prayer. During these days, I will enter into many intensive times of prayer, called holy hours. The rest of the day will be filled with prayerful pondering as I read, pray, and just go about my day in a silent and contemplative manner.

A retreat is not an escape from reality, but rather it puts the retreatant at the heart of the world, formed and shaped by God's love. Each year, priests are required to take at least 5 days for retreat to refocus on the love of God for them and for the world. The 30 day is often a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for most individuals and priests, and provides a more extensive time to be with Jesus and hear the voice of God speaking his love to them. Please pray that I may lay down all resistances and simply trust in God. He will form me into the priest the you and the world need. I deeply desire this continued transfiguration to Christ and I look forward to the surprises God has stored up for me!
