Dear Parishioners,

Happy Father's Day! It is a great day to honor all those men who are father-figures in our lives. As a "spiritual father" I always feel such a special joy in the responsibilities fathers assume. I know my own dad and both of my grandfathers significantly shaped who I am today. In our world, where so many children grow up without a father, I hope and pray we honor and thank those men who accept this role in our lives. The "father" is essential in the family.



This year's parish festival is less than two months away, and plans are well underway! A significant activity at our festival is the raffle. We are very excited to partner with Rick Case Honda in our raffle this year. The grand prize is \$12,500 or a 3-year lease on a Honda Accord! This weekend the raffle tickets are available for each parish household to take. I ask that you pick up your raffle tickets in the back of church. To save us postage, it would also help if you are able to deliver any of your neighbors' tickets. You can also begin signing up to volunteer for the festival at www.srweuclid.cc.

Someone recently asked me about the Time, Talent, and Treasure forms you filled out last fall as well as the ministries you may have signed up for at the Ministry Fair in November. Some people told me they have not heard from anyone. First of all, I am so sorry for this. Please know we appreciate all volunteers and want everyone to have a role in the vibrancy of our parish. Secondly, during my leave of absence and for a few months afterwards, many of the staff members had to pick up extra duties to cover for me. Unfortunately some things slipped through the cracks. If you signed up for a particular ministry, like Prayer Shawl Ministry, Parish Council, Communion to the Homebound, Choir, etc., and have not heard from someone, **please** call me or email me at the parish office. I want to make sure we get you included! I do hope you will take me up on this offer. We keep a database of talents such as baking, office work, landscaping, etc., and if / when we have a need we will call upon you. We truly appreciate having so many talented people! I hope this helps to clarify. Please never be discouraged. Just let me know, and I will find a place for you!

Thank you, thank you, thank you for your generous support in our special appeal. To date we have received and had pledged just under \$150,000 towards our goal of \$240,000. If you have not responded yet, please consider doing so. The new rectory steps/ADA ramp, school electrical upgrades, parking lot repairs, sound system repairs, and new rectory doors are real needs for the safety of parishioners and the vibrancy of ministries. One person recently gave me \$10,000 and said, *"I am not giving this to you. I am not giving this to the parish. I AM GIVING IT TO GOD!"* God is the center of what we do here in the Eucharist and the Sacraments, and in order to ensure support for many generations to come we are all called to examine our treasures. Will you make a sacrificial gift to the parish so we can assure God remains the center of all we do? Obviously not many can give \$10,000, but as I asked, I am hoping each family can give serious consideration to a sacrificial gift of at least \$500 paid all at once or over 5 months. To GOD. Please know from the bottom of my heart I appreciate it. Let me know of any questions/concerns.


To help us, the Conference has provided some very helpful items to assist us in making these days very special opportunities for prayer, education, and reflection. Among the items offered by the USCCB are:
