The Catholic bishops of the world are planning to meet in October 2018 for the 15th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops. The theme of this gathering is "Youth, Faith, and Vocational Discernment." In preparation for this major synod on youth, Pope Francis wants to gather input from the Catholic faithful. Consequently, the Diocese of Cleveland has made available a questionnaire to gather information on the current state of the young in our diocese. The results will be included as part of the pre-synod discernment document. The survey can be found on the diocesan website home page, [www.dioceseofcleveland.org](http://www.dioceseofcleveland.org). All are invited and encouraged to participate by taking this short survey. The bishops of the United States pray that the results of this survey will help them more fully understand the experience of young people in our Church and in our country -- their hopes, dreams, fears, and struggles -- so that the synod may bear fruit in offering more insight and direction to our ministry with young people.

### IS THE JUSTICE SYSTEM JUST?

In an ongoing effort to present pertinent information to communities throughout Lake County, Saint Mary Magdalene Parish will be hosting a forum on Tuesday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> at 6:30 pm in the church. It will focus on what happens at each stage of the justice system when a person is arrested, charged, and convicted of a criminal offense. A panel consisting of a Lake County Police Chief, Lake County Prosecutor Charles E. Coulson, and Lake County Common Pleas Judge John P. O'Donnell will discuss the way the justice system in Lake County actually works. The panel strongly encourages questions from the audience. In past forums held in other communities, the inquiries have focused on whether members of minority classes and those with lower socio-economic status are fairly treated.
