### *Musing from Mike*

Welcome to Ordinary Time! Despite the Church starting back into Ordinary Time just after Pentecost Sunday, we celebrate two Sunday feasts. The feasts of the Most Holy Trinity and the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ are both very important feasts that remind us of the unfathomable level of God's love for the whole world and us. Currently, I am reading a short, yet classic book on prayer; so I thought it would be nice to briefly mention "Adoration" as the first prayer form. Eventually, I would like to share the other three forms of prayer, but this first week let's talk *adoration*.

Fr. Raoul Plus, S.J. states, "We may pray to adore, to give thanks, to implore pardon, or to ask for the graces we need." In *adoration*, we are not concerned with ourselves, as in the last three forms of prayer; rather we move out of ourselves and think of God alone. We often think of a relational-bond, where the husband adores his wife, and the wife adores her husband. One adores the other, to the point of praise. When we stop to take in the depth of God's loving mercy, we adore.

Echoing our brief reflections on the Feast of Corpus Christi, I *again* want to invite you to spend time in our Adoration Chapel with Jesus ~ simply in *adoration*. When we sit with Jesus in amazement of God's deep love for us, we are praying in *adoration*, as we *simply adore*.
